

RED

Make: **A Ladybird**

Red paper
Black paper
P.V.A. glue
Plastic/paper covered bag ties
Adhesive tape
White crayon/chalk
Black crayon

1. Cut out the body shape from the red paper.
2. Cut out the head shape and the spots from the black paper and stick onto the body.
3. Using the white crayon draw 2 eyes.
4. Using the black crayon draw a line down the centre of the body shape.
5. Fix bag ties with the sticky tape as shown - 6 on the body and 2 and on the head.

The ladybird can be left as it is or displayed on a leaf cut from a large sheet of green paper.

Rhyme: Ladybird, ladybird fly away home
Your house is on fire and your children all gone.
All except one and that's little Ann
And she crept under the frying pan!

(Traditional)

Activity: Using a fairly flat smooth stone (from the beach), with P.V.A. glue added to the paint, paint a head black and the rest red. Stick on black felt spots.



Talk About: Stories mentioning red, eg. Little Red Riding Hood, The Little Red Hen.
Encourage the children to tell the stories and to act them out.
